A Little History

In 1970 the residents of this far-flung settlement 20 miles north of Chico formed a community association, the first of its kind in Butte County. They soon followed this by setting up a volunteer fire department. Cohasset residents built their own community center, entirely by local volunteers without the aid of taxpayers' dollars. The first of seven sections of a 300 square foot building was moved up Cohasset Road from Chico Municipal Airport February 13, 1971. The building was purchased from the City of Chico at a token \$10 price. The building was reassembled and formed a garage for the fire engine acquired from the California Disaster Office from surplus stock and for a Community Association meeting hall. In 1974 Cohasset was the first foothill community in the county to come up with its own zoning plan, one which subsequently served for other areas, including Forest Ranch and Butte Creek Canyon. In 2003 a Fire and Evacuation plan was adopted by the Cohasset Community as a guide for preparation and evacuation if required. The Plan is available at the Community Center or from Bert Coffman at 894-5712.

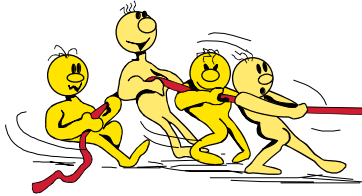
