## It's Time to Join 4-H!

Cohasset 4-H is set to launch a new year of fun-filled projects and leadership opportunities. We are looking forward to seeing YOU and a parent at our first Community Meeting on Wednesday, September 7, at 6:30 p.m. in the CCA building. 4-H is open to all school age youth. If you fit into that age range come on out and see what we have to offer you.

How does 4-H work in Cohasset? First, we have monthly community meetings on the first Wednesday of every month where all Cohasset members join together. They elect club officers,

plan club-wide activities, learn about county-wide activities, and about the projects offered by our local Cohasset club. Midge Vander Velden, the long-time leader of the Cohasset club, has retired after many years of dedicated service. The Community Club Leader this year will be Susana Malcolm. Our club will be offering many exciting projects this year and you can choose to participate in any that might interest you. Each project has separate meeting times that are set by the project leader and the members who choose to participate. (A note to parents: all leaders have been fingerprinted and participated in a leader-training seminar with the 4-H Office.)



### What projects will be offered?

- ✓ Swine: You must be at least 9 years old to participate in this project. If you choose to participate you will raise a pig to show and sell at the Silver Dollar Fair. Lara Conkey-Wiebelhaus is super excited to lead the project this year and will teach you everything you need to know about pigs! You will provide the food and shelter and you will reap the profits!
- ✓ Arts and Crafts: This project usually meets the first Saturday of each month at the CCA building and does a variety of craft and sewing projects. Susana Malcolm leads this group along with junior leaders, Trinity Forrester and Camille Lingemann.
- ✓ Hiking: This group takes a day hike once a month; weather permitting, to some of the most scenic areas in the North State. Last year this group also took a snow trip to Mt. Shasta Ski Park and one to the Aquatic Center at Lake Oroville Forebay. Larry Jansen and Chris Greer are the leaders of this project.
- ✓ Welding: In this project you will be making functional and artistic projects using torch cutting and welding skills. You will be using a variety of recycled and repurposed materials. Of course, safety training will be the first order of business. Jion Lingemann will be the leader of this project and you must be at least 9 years old to participate.
- ✓ Clover Buds: This project is aimed at our 5-8 year old members. It will be an introduction to 4-H and have a variety of fun activities. Heather Lingemann will be the leader.
- ✓ Cooking: This project has been a staple of our program for many years, however, our long-time leader, Linda Hartsong, has retired. This project may return, but is on hold for now.
- ✓ Cross Clubbing: Maybe you looked at all this and thought, I have a friend who does a horse project, or maybe a quilt project with another club. Why can't I do that? The good news is, YOU CAN! If we don't offer the project of your dreams and it is offered with another club in Butte County, you can join the Cohasset Club and participate in the other club's project.

You may be thinking; this is a lot of stuff. I can't do all that! We do have more projects than some much larger clubs. You can sign up for just one project that interests you or as many as you have time for. If any of this sounds like fun to you, come to the meeting on Sept. 7th at 6:30 pm, at the CCA building. The annual cost is \$45 a year. We have

scholarships available to pay a portion of the fees if necessary.

How do I sign-up? You are now able to sign-up online. New and returning members can go to [cebutte.ucanr.edu](http://cebutte.ucanr.edu) to do so. You have three options. You can create a profile and enroll online, print out your forms and bring them to the meeting, or you can download the forms, fill them out

and bring them to the meeting, or you can fill out forms that we provide at the meeting.

Whichever you choose, you pay your fees to the Cohasset 4-H at the meeting. Please call Susana Malcolm at 893-0109 if you have any questions. We hope to see you there!


